DBSA Greater Houston 2012 Satisfaction Survey Results

SUMMARY:

During January 2012, DBSA conducted its annual "*Participant Satisfaction Survey*". The survey provides both quality improvement and assurance metrics that are used to improve DBSA's delivery of services.

RESULTS:

DBSA received responses from <u>43</u> out of a possible <u>45</u> support group locations with <u>281</u> individuals completing the survey.

Overall, DBSA had an average score of <u>4.21</u> out of a possible 5, with 1 representing "poor" and 5 representing "excellent"
